COVID-19 Statement

Welcome to the first event at the fantastic Bowood Estate in the Future Outlaw Run Series 2021. Guidance for this event is designed to help mitigate the spread of Covid-19 as well as deliver an event where all children, crew, volunteers, suppliers, and any supporters feel safe and have an enjoyable experience.

In line with government guidance, we would recommend that parents/guardians/carers attending the event complete a lateral flow test and only travel to the event should they return a negative result. If you or

your child feel unwell in the lead up to the event, please DO NOT attend and seek medical advice.

We encourage everyone over the age of 12 that comes onto the event site to please wear a face covering. This does not apply when racing.

Please also be mindful and respectful of fellow competitors and the volunteers that have given their time to enable this race to go ahead, and maintain social distancing where appropriate.

We hope you have a great event and just remember the overriding priority is to have fun and stay SAFE.

Welcome

Welcome the first Future Outlaw Run Event. This event is based entirely within the grounds of the Bowood Estate and competitors will have the opportunity to run down the carpeted Outlaw finishing line in front of the Grandstand.

Both events will start the close to the finish line, close the main gardens of Bowood House. The 1.2 mile will start first, followed by the 2.4 mile approx. 5 minutes later.

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We ask that runners spread themselves before the start of the event & try to maintain some social distancing.

Who can take part in the Future Outlaw Run?

The run is a fun event aimed at children from 4 years up to 15 years old. Parents of younger runners are allowed to run with them if they want that little bit of extra support to complete the event.

This event offers the younger members of the family the opportunity to get involved in the weekend's events in a safe and fun environment. All finishers will receive a special Future Outlaw medal.

Confirmation of Entry

Competitors are requested to check on the list of entries posted on the web site to confirm that they have been successful in their application.

Refreshments

The venue has cafes on site which serves warm and cold food & drink. There will also be a range of catering units around the main event site.

What Will You Need?

For the run we suggest competitors wear very simple clothes and trainers which they feel comfortable running in. All of the surfaces will be in good condition and firm under foot.

Race Rules

This is very simple, have fun and smile for the whole Run!

Registration & Race Packs

The Registration Marquee will be located in the main event field. Please follow the wayfinding signs for Enquiries. Enquiries will be open Saturday between 12:00 – 14:00 for collecting Race Packs. Your race pack will contain a race number with a timing chip attached to be back.

We will be accepting entries on the day for this event at a cost of £12.00

Race Numbers

Please do not cut, fold or tare your race numbers. Race numbers must be worn on the competitor's front during the event at all times.

Please do not tamper with the race number and do not forget to bring your own safety pins.

Race Briefing

There will be a race briefing approximately 5 minutes before the start of the event. This will take place in the start area. The race briefing will inform you of any last minute route changes and safety points. If you have any questions or queries on race day, please ask them after the race briefings.

The Course

The 1.2 mile mini run is a very simple out and back, turning around a cone, and then returning back towards the main events site, before make a right in the direction of the transition and final left to the finish line.

The 2.4 mile junior run heads further down in the Bowood Estate, in the shape of a figure of 8. Some advice, the start is all downhill, so save some energy for the return section back up to the finish line.

Medical Conditions

We request that all competitors have their next of kin & contact details on the back of their race numbers using a waterproof pen. If your child has any type of medical condition or are taking any type of medication please write a large 'MC' on the bottom left of their race number. Please write their medical condition fully on the back of their number also. This will only be used in the event of them being involved in an accident.

Medical Cover

The safety of our competitors is paramount. Onsite during the event will be a specialist medical company set up to supply the highest calibre of comprehensive medical cover to sporting events such as this. On the day there will be a team of first-aiders, nurses and state registered Paramedics. If before, during or after the event you feel that your competitor will require any type of medical care, please do not hesitate to contact an event marshal.

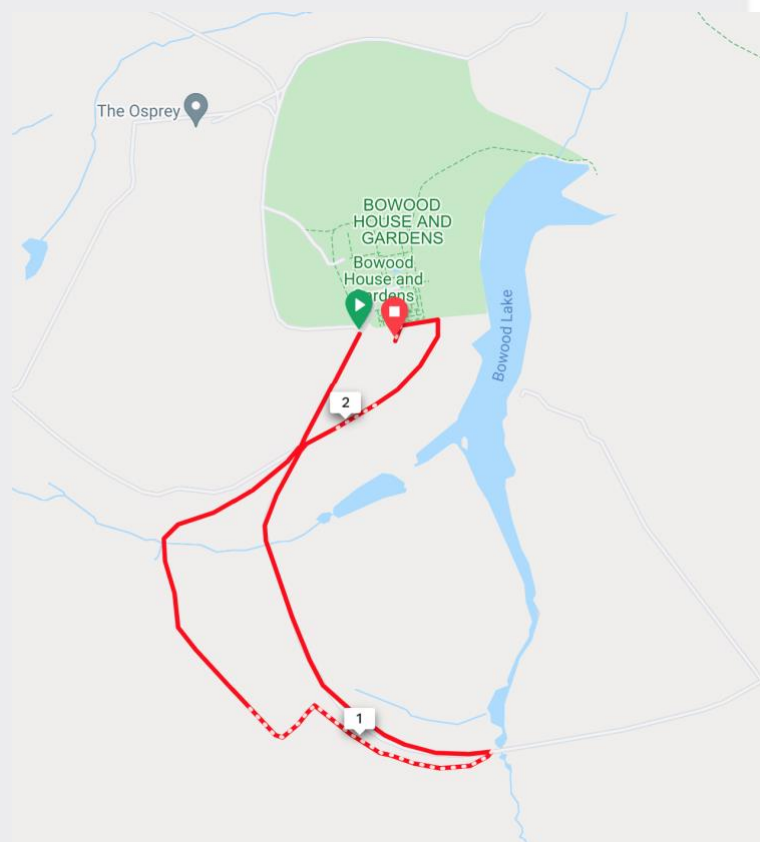
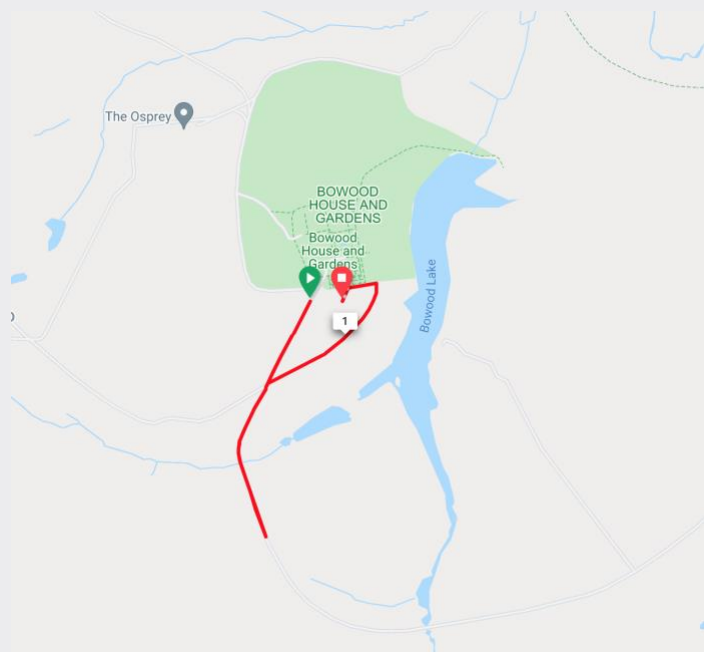
