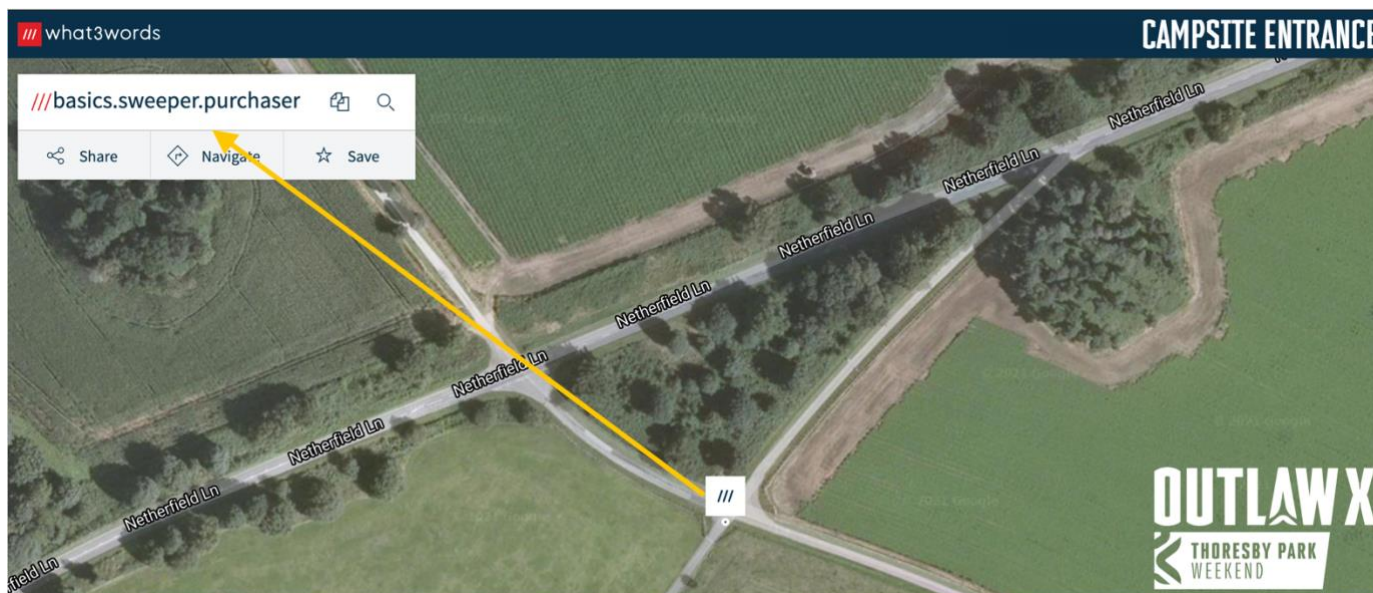

Within this document, we hope to provide you with the information you will require so that your camping experience will go as smoothly as possible.

Camping on the Thoresby Estate is a very rare occurrence, not only will you be able to camp in a stunning location, the entrance to the Campsite is just 600m away from transition.

What do I need to check in?

When you first check in, we will need to see the email confirmation of your booking. We will only need to see this the first time you arrive. Your details will then be crossed checked as you enter the campsite. Without the email it will significantly slow down your check in process & might result in you not being allowed onto the site.

Who can camp?

You need to be 17 years old to be able to book camping at the event, although you are allowed to bring children under this age to camp with you.

How many people can I have in my group?

The site has been planned to enable each group to have a maximum of 6 people per pitch & only one vehicle. This applies to tents, caravans and camper vans. Additional vehicles please collect a **CAMPSITE PARKING PASS** when checking in. Additional cars can be parked in the volunteers car park.

Are pets allowed on the campsite?

Yes, well behaved & quiet pets are welcome on the campsite. Please ensure that any animal mess is picked up & disposed of into official bins.

Will the campsite be secure?

In order to gain access after you have initially checked in you and your party will need to be wearing the wristband which you will be issued on arrival. It is recommended that no valuables are left unattended on the campsite.

How do I access the campsite?

There will be specific campsite entrance and exit routes. Please following the camping event signs.

Are there set pitches and can I reserve a block together?

The pitches will be marked out, they will be approx. 8 x 6 metres and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Sorry we are unable to save pitches for groups. If you wish to camp together, please arrive together.

What facilities will be available?

There will be toilets, pot & hand washing facilities & shower blocks. These will be based within the secure camping compound and for the use of those people that have booked to camp only.

There will be a drinking water supply available to all campsite users on the front and side edge of the campsite. Electrical hook ups will be available only if purchased in advance.

Vehicle Restrictions

Due to both height, width & weight restrictions, we are unable to accommodate vehicles in excess of the following:

Height:	5.4metres
Width:	3.3 metres
Weight:	8.25 tonnes

Leaving the campsite – during the weekend

You will be able to leave & return to the campsite on Saturday until 10pm, after this point, the main gates will be locked and it will not be possible to return onto the site. On Sunday, you will be able to leave the campsite after 12noon, and return before 10pm. Again the main gates will be locked from 10pm. On Monday morning, you must leave before 10am.

In the event of an emergency!

In the event of a fire there will be extinguishers on the Campsite, please notify the check in staff. If the check in is closed, please contact the following emergency contacts – 07843 470451.

CAMPSITE RULES

- Wear Your Campsite Wristbands At All Times
- No Portable BBQ's / Fires / Fireworks / Chinese Lanterns
- No Sleeping In Cars Overnight
- No Vehicles Longer Than 8 Metres
- All Litter Must Be Put Into The Bins Provided
- Speed Limit Is 5mph
- Children Must Be Supervised
- No Generators Allowed
- Only One Car Per Pitch
- Do Not Empty Caravan Waste Into The Portaloo's
- Noise

Please be considerate to all users of the estate. If you are deemed to be making too much noise you will be asked politely to lower the volume to a considerate level. Failure to do so will result in you being removed from the site.
