Future Outlaw Run Series - Nottingham Race Information

Welcome to the first Future Outlaw Run of 2022 - please read this race information to help prepare for a great day and a fantastic finish on the famous Outlaw orange carpet!

Future Outlaw Events

Future Outlaw events are a great opportunity for younger members of the family to get involved in the Outlaw weekend and enjoy the race experience in a safe and fun environment.

This Future Outlaw Run is based entirely within the grounds of the National Water Sports Centre. The emphasis is on fun and participation and all finishers get to run down the finish chute in front of the Grandstand before receiving their special Future Outlaw Medal.

Who can take part?

The event is for children from 4 to 15 years old. Parents or guardians of younger runners can run with them if they want a bit of extra support.

How to enter

You can enter [on line](#) until 9th May to guarantee your place in advance. Please keep your confirmation email once you complete your online entry. Entries can be bought on the day (subject to availability) for £12.00, please visit our Enquiries team in the Event Village.

Covid 19

As Covid 19 is still prevalent, we encourage you not to attend the event if you feel unwell or are displaying any of the latest Covid 19 symptoms.

Getting to the National Water Sports Centre

Roadworks are taking place around the National Water Sports Centre – please allow extra time for your journey.

Sat-Nav users are advised to use the named location “Holme Pierrepont National Water Sports Centre” rather than the postcode, as some Sat-Nav’s will direct you to Colwick Race Course on the opposite side of the river.

From the South: Turn off at junction 24 of the M1, take the A453 to Nottingham and then the A52 to Grantham. Follow signs to the National Water Sports Centre.

From the North: Turn off at junction 26 of the M1, take the A610 and then the A52 to Grantham. Follow signs to the National Water Sports Centre.

Nottingham Train Station is 15 minutes by car.

Car Parking

The venue is charging for parking. You can purchase in advance online until 5th May and your pass will be sent to you. If you purchase in advance, the cost is £5 for the Saturday only or £8.50 for the weekend. Tickets can be purchased on arrival (cash only, a £10 charge will apply for the weekend pass).

As you approach the National Water Sports Centre on Adbolton Lane, aim for the following what3words address: ///moral.ropes.robe and then follow the directions of the Parking Stewards to the next available car park.

Please do not park on the roads at any point during the race weekend, it is dangerous and affects our relationship with the highways department - thank you!

Facilities

The venue has cafes on site which serves hot and cold food & drink and there will also be a range of catering units around the main event site. Toilets are available. Dogs are welcome on site (on lead please).

What to bring to the Race

You will need to bring comfortable trainers, running clothes and either safety pins or a race belt to attach your Race number. All the course surfaces are in good condition and will be firm underfoot.

Collecting your Race Number and Wrist Band

You can register and collect your Race Number at our Enquiries marquee in the Event Village between 12:00 – 14:00 on Saturday. Your Race number has your timing chip attached to the back and a detachable wristband portion.

You should wear your number on your front for the entire event (remember your safety pins or race belt!). Please do not deface, fold or tear your Race Number in any way to ensure that your number remains visible.

PARENT WRISTBANDS

Due to the Finish location, parents cannot meet up with their children directly at the finish line. Children will be guided to a Family Collection Point location in reception.

Race numbers have a detachable matching wristband, please tear this off before they race and bring it with you when collecting your child from the Family Collection Point after the race.

If you are comfortable with your child making their own way back to meet you, do not detach the wristband. Children whose wristband is still attached to their race number will be allowed to leave the Family Collection Point unaccompanied.

Medical Conditions

We ask all competitors to write their next of kin & contact details on the back of their race numbers using a waterproof pen. If your child has a medical condition or are taking any medication, please write a large 'MC' on the bottom left of their race number and their medical condition fully on the back of their number also. This will only be used in the event of them being involved in an accident and requiring treatment.

Medical Cover

The safety of our competitors is paramount. Onsite during the event will be a specialist medical company set up to supply the highest calibre of comprehensive medical cover to sporting events such as this. On the day there will be a team of first-aiders, nurses and a state registered Paramedic.

If before, during or after the event you feel that your competitor will require any type of medical care, please do not hesitate to contact an event marshal.

Race Briefing and Rules

The rules are very simple: have fun and smile for the whole Run! There will be a briefing in the Start area approximately 5 minutes before the start of the event to ensure everyone knows how to follow the route and any key safety points. If you have any questions or queries on race day, you can ask them at the race briefings.

The Race

Both events will start close to the finish line, in front of the grandstand area. The 1.2 mile will start first, followed by the 2.4 mile approx. 5 minutes later. Runners will be set off in pairs or small groups, they will queue up along the edge of the lake and there will be gap of a few seconds between each pair or group starting.



The route is an anti-clockwise loop, 1 lap for the 1.2 mile and 2 lap for the 2.4 mile – you can see the interactive map of the route here <https://ridewithgps.com/routes/35364784>.

After completing the first lap, the 1.2 mile runners need to take the left to the finish gantry. For the 2.4 mile runners, they will take the right lane, past the finish gantry, to complete the second lap.

There will be a lead bike with the runners on the course as well as our marshals who will help to guide runners and provide encouragement - remember to smile when you see them!

Meeting up after the Race

Family and friends can watch competitors run down the finish line from the Grandstand area before heading to Family Collection Point inside the building.

Participants will cross the line and collect their medal before being guided up the metal staircase to the Reception Floor of the main building. Spectators will come into the building via the Main Doors and turn right to meet up with their runner.

Wristband has been detached from Race Number - Children will be held in the Family Collection Point area until an adult with the matching wristband arrives to collect them.

Wristband has not been detached from Race Number - Children will be allowed to make their own way back to family

Please do not delay in collecting your children once they have finished – we don't want anyone to finish their Race experience being worried and it is also important that we can allow our volunteer Marshalls to finish on time.
