Welcome to the Future Outlaw, part of the Outlaw Holkham Half Weekend 2023

The Future Outlaw is a great opportunity for younger members of the family to get involved in the Outlaw Half Holkham weekend and enjoy the race experience in a safe and fun environment. The emphasis is on fun and participation and there is a choice of two distances: Mini 1.2 mile or Junior 2.4 mile.

In addition to the Future Outlaw, the Outlaw Holkham Half Weekend has the Holkham 10k on Saturday morning and the ever popular Outlaw Half Triathlon on the Sunday. The Event Village will be open all weekend, so please enjoy the atmosphere and stay to support your fellow athletes.

Entries

Mini entries are open to children age 4-15, Junior Entries are for children age 8-15. Entries can be purchased online until 3 July. Please keep a copy of your confirmation email handy. After this, entries will be only available on the day at £10 (subject to availability).

Parents or guardians are welcome to run with children if they would like a little extra support.

Getting here

Holkham Hall is two miles west of Wells-next-the-Sea on the A149.

By Car: Cars should follow the brown tourist signs indicated from Fakenham or Wells-next-the-Sea. The main entrance for cars is via the north gates to the estate in Park Road, by The Victoria.

Event parking will be in operation – please follow the direction of the Stewards.

- One Day Tickets – if you have pre-purchased a 1 day ticket, please show your electronic parking permit. Otherwise you can pay on the day (£5)
- Weekend tickets – if you pre-purchased a 2 day ticket, please show your electronic permit otherwise you can pay £10 at the gate. Please ensure you then visit Enquiries with either your permit or gate receipt to exchange it for a Swing

Ticket which must be displayed when returning on Sunday.

By Train: The nearest train stations are Cromer (25 miles) and Sheringham (19 miles) on the Bittern Line from Norwich. There are direct trains to Norwich from London and the Midlands as well as Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft. King's Lynn (27 miles) has direct trains from London via Cambridge and Ely. Connecting buses run to Holkham.

By Bus: There is a frequent bus service to Holkham Village from Kings Lynn via Hunstanton, also from Fakenham via Wells. There is also a frequent service from Cromer via Sheringham to Wells-next-the-Sea, with onward connection to Holkham. The Hall is reached via Park Road, a beautiful walk of about 1 mile (allow 30 minutes).

By Bike: Holkham Park is on National Cycle Route 1 and is easily accessible from nearby towns and villages with bicycles able to enter Holkham Park via the North, South, East and West gates. Bicycle racks can be found in the Stables courtyard and at the Walled Garden

Venue & Facilities

You and your family will be able to enjoy the beautiful grounds and wildlife of the estate. Holkham Hall has a café on site serving a range of hot and cold refreshments. The Outlaw Event Village will also have a range of catering

units and exhibitors. There will also be a water refill station in the Event Village.

Toilets are available however there are no change facilities or bag drop on site.

IMPORTANT: PARENT WRISTBANDS

Due to the layout of the Finish, parents cannot meet up with the children immediately at the Finish Line. Children will be guided through to the exit end of the Finishers' Enclosure where they can wait to be collected.

Race numbers have a detachable matching wristband, please tear this off before they race and bring it with you when collecting your child.

If you are comfortable with your child making their own way back to meet you, do not detach the wristband. Children whose wristband is still attached to their race number will be allowed to leave the Finishers' enclosure unaccompanied.

Safety of our competitors is paramount and during the event we will be supported by a specialist medical team. If before, during or after the event you feel your competitor required medical care, please contact an event marshal.

Registration & Race Numbers

To collect pre purchased Race Numbers or to register for On The Day entries, please visit our team in the Registration Marquee from 10:00am.

Your race number will have a timing chip embedded into it and has a detachable wristband portion for parents. Race numbers will be different colours for Juniors and Minis.

Please bring a race belt or safety pins to attach your race number to your front where it must be displayed on your front at all times during the event. Please do not fold, tear or deface your number in any way.

Please write emergency contact details and medical information on the back of the race number (and a large MC on the bottom left corner of the front) using a waterproof pen, this can save vital time in the event of you requiring assistance.

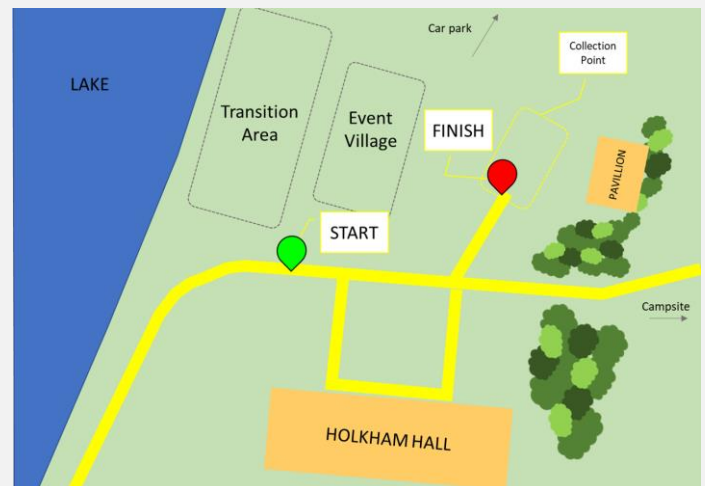
Briefing & Rules

The rules are very simple: have fun and smile on your way round! There will be a short briefing just prior to the event starting, to make sure everyone knows where they are going and any last minute changes or safety points.

The Route

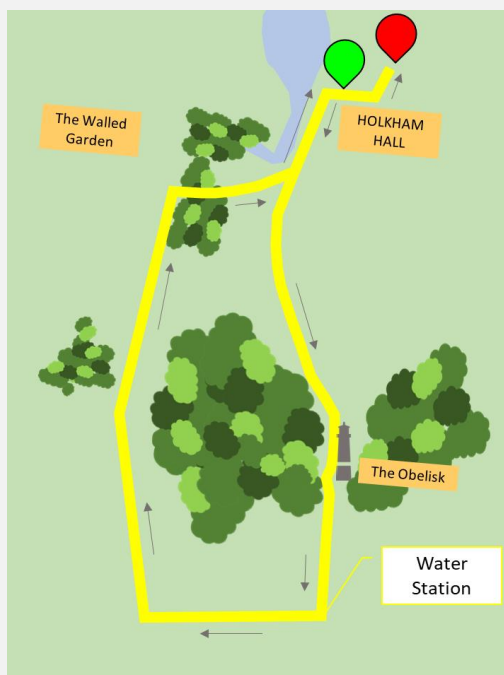
Both events begin near the event village and finish on the famous Outlaw orange carpet in the event village. The route will be signposted and marshals will be available to help direct you.

Participants will meet in the Event Village near the start line, listen out to the commentary team for directions. The Juniors will be briefed first before being led to the Start Line where they will begin as one group. The Minis event will start approximately 5 mins later.

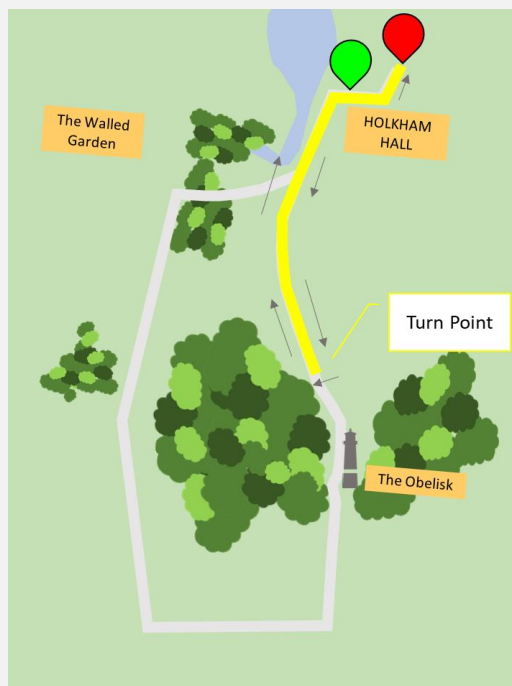


The Juniors will complete a 2.4 mile loop, heading up past the Obelisk before turning right to run around the farm tracks towards the Walled Garden and then heading back down towards the Hall and the finish chute.

The Minis will complete a 1.2 mile out and back loop which takes them up towards the Obelisk before turning back to head to the finish chute.



A drink station with Water will be available on the Junior Route, approximately halfway round or you are welcome to carry your own hydration to avoid using disposables. Please do not drop litter anywhere other than in designated bins.
