Welcome to the Future Outlaw, part of the Outlaw X Weekend 2023

The Future Outlaw is a great opportunity for younger members of the family to get involved in the Outlaw X weekend and enjoy the race experience in a safe and fun environment. The emphasis is on fun and participation and there is a choice of two distances: Mini 1.2 mile or Junior 2.4 mile.

The Outlaw X Triathlon will be on the Sunday and the Event Village will be open all weekend, so please enjoy the atmosphere and stay to support your fellow athletes.

### **Entries**

Entries for the Mini (1.2 mile) are open to children aged 4-14 years and the Junior (2.4 mile) is for children aged 8-15. Entries can be purchased online until 28 August - please keep a copy of your confirmation email handy. After this, entries will be available on the day at £10 (subject to availability).

Parents or guardians are welcome to run with children if they would like a little extra support.

# Getting here

## **IMPORTANT: PARKING ACCESS**

There will no access to the Car Parks or Campsite until after 10:30 on Saturday due to the Outlaw Sprint Race taking place. Please don't arrive before this time.

Parking will be available – you can purchase in advance until the 28 August or purchases can be made on the day for £5 (or £10 for a weekend pass) please bring cash – you will need to collect your pass from Registration and display it upon exit. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk.

There will be 1 athlete car park in operation across the event weekend accessed via Gates 1 & 2 off Netherfield Lane. If you are travelling from the A614 you should access the athlete car park using Gate 1. If you are

travelling from the Budby end of Netherfield Lane you should access the car park via Gate 2. Disabled, Volunteer and Officials parking is accessible via Gate 3. All Gates will be managed by a Parking Team, please follow their instructions on where to park.

## Venue & Facilities

You and your family will be able to enjoy the beautiful grounds and wildlife of the estate. Thoresby Park has a café on site serving a range of hot and cold refreshments. The Outlaw Event Village will also have catering units and exhibitors.

Toilets are available; However, there are no change facilities or bag drop on site.

The safety of our competitors is paramount and during the event we will be supported by a specialist medical team. If before, during or after the event you feel your





competitor requires medical care, please contact an event marshal.

# Registration & Race Numbers

To collect pre purchased Race Numbers or purchase On The Day entries, please visit our team in the Registration Marquee from 10:00am.

Your race number will have a timing chip embedded into it and has a detachable wristband portion for parents. Race numbers will be blue for Minis and orange for Juniors.

### **IMPORTANT: PARENT WRISTBANDS**

Due to the layout of the Finish, parents cannot meet up with the children immediately at the Finish Line. Children will be guided through to the exit of the secure Finishers' Enclosure where they can wait to be collected.

Race numbers have a detachable matching wristband, please tear this off before they race and bring it with you when collecting your child.

If you are comfortable with your child making their own way back to meet you, do not detach the wristband. Children whose wristband is still attached to their race number will be allowed to leave the Finishers' Enclosure unaccompanied.

Please bring a race belt or safety pins to attach your race number to your front where it must be displayed on at all times during the event. Please do not fold, tear or deface your number in any way.

Please write emergency contact details and medical information on the back of the race number (and a large MC on the bottom left corner of the front) using a waterproof pen, this can save vital time in the event of your child requiring assistance.

### Meeting up after the Race

Family and friends can watch competitors run down the finish chute before heading towards the back of the Finishers Enclosure to meet up.

# **Briefing & Rules**

The rules are very simple: have fun and smile on your way round! There will be a short briefing just prior to the event starting, to make sure everyone knows where they are going and if there are any last-minute changes or safety points.

Wear clothes and shoes you feel comfortable running in, the ground should generally be firm underfoot, but some sections will be on uneven surfaces.


### The Route

Both events begin near the event village and finish on the famous Outlaw orange carpet. Participants will meet at the start line, listen out to the commentary team for directions of where to go. The Juniors will be briefed first before starting as one group. The Minis event will start a couple of minutes later. The route will be signposted, and marshals will be available to direct you.


Minis will complete one lap of the course, following a short out and back section before turning right to head through the woods (where the ground will be a little uneven) and looping around above the start line before heading towards the Finish chute.







Juniors will follow the same route but complete two laps before heading to the finish.



A drink station with Water will be available approximately halfway round the Junior Route, you are welcome to carry your own hydration to avoid using disposables. Please do not drop litter anywhere other than in designated bins.
